



# Launch of MTB 219 in Bridgwater Docks

## Saturday 31st January 2015



**At Durleigh Displays, 5 Symons Way, Bridgwater, TA6 4DR:**

7:30am - Cranes and Transport Arrive

8:00am – Strop up MTB219 and load onto Transport

10:00am – Transport with MTB 219 will set off to Docks

**At Bowerings Feeds, Provender Mill, Bridgwater, TA6 3EX**

11:15-11:30am – ETA for MTB 219, escorted by Sea Cadet Band

11:30 – 12:00pm – MTB 219 will be prepared for launch, cava and sparkling water will be distributed.

12:00pm – Speech by Bridgwater Mayor, Cllr Steve Austin; speech by Cllr Peter Downing, Chair of Sedgemoor Council, speech by PBCC, speech by BSC, Toast by Mrs Elsie Carter

12:10pm onwards – MTB 219 craning into the Docks.

### **MTB 219 Launch Route**

219 will leave Symons Way, and turn left onto East Quay. At the traffic lights by Currys and the Car Wash she will turn right onto The Clink. She will proceed through the traffic lights, onto Northgate, past the Council Offices, past the Police Station and the back of Angel Place Shopping Centre (Mount Street), continuing past Scott Cinema to the Mecca Bingo roundabout. At the roundabout she will turn right onto Penel Orlieu. At the traffic lights she will turn right again onto North Street. At the Maltshovel roundabout she will turn right, onto Victoria Road, which bends off to the left. As Victoria Road curves back to the right it becomes Kendale Road. She will then turn right into Coleridge Road. At the roundabout she will then take the second exit (turning left) which is sign posted as “T” (no through road). She will then be joined by the Bridgwater Sea Cadet Band who will escort her past the Bowerings Animal Feeds Yard onto the side of Bridgwater Docks.

We would request pedestrians to carry straight on through the concrete bollards and muster in front of the flats. If the weather is bad, Bridgwater Sea Cadets have kindly given us the use of their building T.S. Blake, which is further on at the North East corner of the docks, opposite side to Admiral’s Landing (address: Waverley Road, TA6 3EX) and available from 10:30am

There is a car park on Mount Street, then cut across the field - **Please do not park on any streets on route!**
